Pig welfare around slaughter and impacts on meat quality

Dr Antonio Velarde holds a Veterinarian Sciences degree, PhD in Animal Production, and Master's in the Science and Welfare of Laboratory Animals. He is European veterinary specialist in Animal Welfare Science, Ethics and Law at the European College of Animal Welfare and Behaviour Medicine. Currently, he is head of the Animal Welfare Program at the Institute for Food and Agricultural Research and Technology, Spain (IRTA) and a member of the Animal Health and Animal Welfare Panel of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA). Antonio is president of the WOAHA Ad hoc group in charge of the revision of Chapter 7.5. - Slaughter of animals and Chapter 7.6. - Killing of animals for disease control purposes, and a member, as an independent expert, of the EU Platform on Animal Welfare. He has published about 200 peer reviewed papers in international journals and co-edited three books: 'On farm monitoring of pig welfare' (Wageningen Academic Publishers), 'Animal welfare at slaughter' (5m Publishing, Sheffield, UK) and 'Bienestar Animal.
